SUBJECT : **ENJOINING ALL SCHOOL OFFICIALS AT THE FOREFRONT  
IN ADVOCATING THE SCHOOL-BASED IMMUNIZATION**

DATE : August 26, 2015

This pertains to the results of the Consultative Meeting between the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Department of Health (DOH) on August 14, 2015 in Metro Manila, which emphasized *the need for large coverage of Grades I and VII pupils/students* to be vaccinated with combination of Measles Rubella (MR) and Tetanus-diphtheria (Td) to ensure high levels of protection against vaccine-preventable diseases.

In this regard, this Office hereby directed COMPLIANCE on the abovementioned subject by all the concerned especially in advocating to all parents to allow their children to be immunized, underscoring the benefits of the vaccines. With high cost of hospitalization nowadays, the best option is still preventable measures including vaccination.

Public Schools District Supervisors are advised to submit reports on the advocacy efforts the school heads have initiated relative herein to the Health and Nutrition Section.
