Subject : Mass Training for Multigrade Teachers

Date : November 17, 2015

1. The Department of Education through the Bureau of Elementary Education is strengthening the implementation of the Multigrade Program in Philippine Education.
2. The Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte will conduct a Five-day Live-In Mass Training for Multigrade Teachers in two batches : First batch- December 14-18, 2015 ; Second batch – December 19-23, 2015. The venue will be announced after the proper bidding and procurement process has been made.
3. Objectives of the activity are the following:
 - a. define basic and important concepts in multigrade instruction and the role teachers play in this kind of teaching,
 - b. present the implications of Multigrade Teaching in the educational system ,
 - c. make the teacher adapt in structuring a Multigrade classroom,
 - d. enhance teacher's skills in managing differentiated instruction that can help address the needs of academically diverse learners in the multigrade classroom,
 - e. introduce teachers to the effective approaches, methodologies, and strategies in handling Multigrade classes.
4. Total number of participants per district for this training is listed in enclosure No.1 while the list of facilitators is in enclosure No. 2.
5. The teacher participants shall be given two days service credit on their attendance during Saturday and Sunday.
6. Travelling and other incidental expenses of the participants and facilitators are chargeable to school MOOE while their accommodation, meals and snacks are chargeable to the downloaded Multigrade Funds.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
