- To further achieve the principles of merit and fitness, objectivity and uniformity in evaluation, and strengthening of the selection process for other teaching, related teaching and non-teaching personnel in this Division, the PSB is directed to strictly abide by the guidelines stipulated in the aforecited DepEd order.
