Recognizing the significant role and contributions of the Parents in the development, implementation and evaluation of school programs, projects and activities, the Department of Education has then issued DepEd Order No. 54 s. 2009 *Revised Guidelines Governing Parents-Teachers Association (PTAs) at the School Level* and DepEd Order No. 77 s. 2009 *Guidelines for the Conduct of Elections of the Parents-Teachers Associations (PTAs) at the School Level and their Federations* which strengthens the institutionalization of the PTAs providing further specific roles, accountabilities and operations and defines the rules and procedures and timetable for the election of the PTA across the country, respectively.
2. This Office, in its fullest support to these policies, has directed the school heads and district supervisors to strictly observe these guidelines at all levels of basic education. Furthermore, with the intention of strengthening the participation and involvement of the PTA and generating maximum support in the implementation of necessary educational reforms and initiatives, this Office is very pleased to announce the conduct of the subject on 11 August 2017 (venue to follow).
