

- 1. Pursuant to President Proclamation No. 476 dated October 7, 1994, November of every year was declared as "Filipino Values Month". In connection with this, the field is hereby informed that the Division Values Education/Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) will hold its 2017 DIVISION FILIPINO VALUES MONTH CELEBRATION, with its theme "Sa K to 12, Sama-sama, sa EsP Kayang-Kaya". This will be conducted on November 17, 2017 at Sindangan Pilot Demonstration School, poblacion Sindangan, Zamboanga del Norte.
- 2. The prime objective of this celebration is to enhance and awaken our moral and national consciousness on human values as part of the moral recovery of the national government.
- 3. All schools in the division are encouraged to participate in this event. The planned activities are anchored on the character for the month which in WISDOM versus FOOLISHNESS in the classroom.

- 5. Relative to the said activity, the winners in the district/congressional levels will compete in the Division Level and that will be conducted on the following dates:

School Level ----November 6, 2017

District Level ---- November 13, 2017

Division Level --- November 17, 2017 from 7:30 A.M.to 5:00 P.M. at SPDS, Sindangan, Z.N.

- 6. The participants to this activity during the Division Level will be the winning students/pupils in the different levels with their teacher-coaches and school coordinators in-charge of EsP.
- 7. The schools are expected to conduct a culminating activity on the last week of November. All activities must be documented and submit accomplishment report to the division on or before December 11, 2017.
- 8. Herewith is the enclosure of the Division Guidelines/Mechanics and Criteria in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition. This will also serve as the criteria for our District and Division Level EsP Competitions.
- 9. Transportation and other allowable expenses of the participants and coaches both for cluster/districts and secondary teachers shall be charged against MOOE or other sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.

GUIDELINES/MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR 2017 EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO COMPETITION

- a. Tagis-Talino
 - 1. There will be one entry per category (elementary and secondary) composed of three (3) participants in each team/category. For the elementary category, the team is composed of Grade IV, V, & VI pupils while the secondary category is composed of Grade 7, 8 & 9 students.
 - 2. The contestants shall bring and wear their IDs for checking and verification.
 - 3. The team will compete in three rounds, namely, the Easy (1pt.), Average (3 pts.) and Difficult (5 pts.) levels.
 - 4. The quizmaster will read each test question twice and after the 2nd reading the quizmaster will signal for the raising of their answers. The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
 - 5. The five teams with the highest scores will be declared winners. (Champion, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Runners-up). The top 3 teams will receive individual medals with certificates and the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.
- b. Minus-One Praise Song
 - 1. There will be one entry either male or female per category (1-elementary & 1 secondary) every Division.
 - 2. The song must be either English or Filipino and must be a song of praise or worship or religious/inspirational.
 - 3. It must be a whole song and not be remixed.
 - 4. The contestant and the teacher-coach must check the minus one with the sound system in-charge to ensure that the CD/USB is functional and that no vocal/lyrics heard once it is on.
 - 5. The following are the criteria for judging:

 Diction and Clarity

 Stage Presence
 15%

 Audience Impact

- 6. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1st, 2nd, 3rd placers will receive medals with certificates while the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.
- 7. The decision of judges is irrevocable and final.

- c. On-The-Spot Poster Making
 - 1. There will be one (1) entry per Congressional Districts. (Three from the elementary and three from the secondary.)
 - 2. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials.
 - a. 1 whole illustration board
 - b. Pencil; and pastel/cray pass/water color
 - 3. The theme/topic shall be given ten (10) minutes before the contest proper. Teacher-coaches can still give their final coaching to the participants before the start of the contest.
 - 4. Contestants are given 1 hour and 30 minutes (1 & $\frac{1}{2}$) to finish the work.
 - 5. Letterings and boarders are not allowed as part of the presentation.
 - 6. All entries shall be judged based on the following criteria:

 Creativity
 20%

 Originality
 20%

 Visual Impact
 20%

d. Essay Writing Contest (medium: Filipino)

- 1. There will be one entry per category (1 elementary and 1 secondary).
- 2. The contest must be written in Filipino.
- 3. The contest is simultaneous and the contestants are only given one (1) hour to finish the essay.
- 4. The essay must have a minimum limit of words according to Elementary grade level: I -30 words, III-60 words, III-80 words, IV-100 words, V & VI -150 words and for secondary grades 7- 200 words, 8-250 words, 9-300words, 10- 350 words.
- 5. The theme/topic shall be given ten (10) minutes before the contest proper. Teacher-coaches can still give their final coaching to the participants before the start of the contest. No writing material is allowed during the 10-minute preparation.
- 6. The criteria of the contest are the following:

 Originality
 30%

 Structure
 15%

 Style
 15%

- 7. There will be three (3) winners in this contest. Only the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placers will receive personalized medals with certificates while the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.
- 8. Decision of judges is final and irrevocable.

In order to determine the Over-all Champion both elementary and secondary categories, points of 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2 shall be given to the first, second, third, fourth and fifth ranks respectively in Essay Writing, On the Spot Poster Making and Minus-One Praise Song Contests. The non-winners will be given 1 point. In the Tagis-talino, points of 10, 9, 8, 7 shall be given to the first, second, third, fourth and fifth ranks respectively and 5 points shall be given to the non-winners.

Plaques of Recognition shall be given to the Over-all Champion, First and Second Runner-Up.
