1. In support to the Youth Formation and Development's goal re: "to empower Filipino children and youth who are responsible, hardworking, enterprising, persevering, value-driven and culturally-rooted equipped with world class skills imbued with values such as maka-Diyos, maka-Tao, maka-Bayan at maka-Kalikasan;" this office announces the conduct of a Consultative and Planning Conference for all the Educational Leaders at Top Plaza Hotel Dipolog City, on August 10, 2017.

- 2. The objectives of the said activity are the following:
