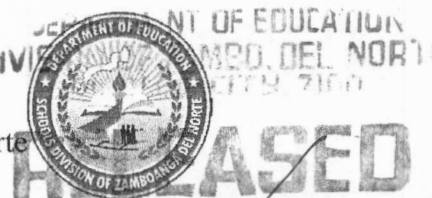

SUBJECT: **DIVISION LIVE-IN MASS TRAINING OF TRAINERS IN MAPEH THROUGH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MUSICARTPEH PROGRAM**

Date: December 29, 2017

1. The Zamboanga del Norte Division will conduct a 4 – Day Live-in Division Mass Training of Trainers in MAPEH through the implementation of MUSICARTPEH Program on January 9-12, 2018 at Top Plaza Hotel, Dipolog City.
2. The objectives of this Training-Workshop are as follows:
 - enhance teachers' skills and strategies in teaching MAPEH specifically in Note Reading and learning the Elements of Music in both elementary and secondary levels
 - develop the conceptual understanding and functional skills of teachers in music, dance, arts, and playing musical instruments
 - organize school choir, rondalla and combo lata group in the elementary and secondary schools using the localized/indigenous and scrap materials found in the locality
 - manifest a sense of nationalism through deepend appreciation of folks songs and dances, filipino culture and arts among teachers
3. The participants to this Training-Workshop are Grade1- Grade 12 teachers actually teaching music. Each district will send one (1) participant from each grade level as mentioned, a total of 12 teachers per district. The said teachers will be the facilitators/trainers during the district Echo –Seminar workshop in MAPEH through the implementation of MUSICARTPEH Program.
4. Participants are required to bring **Barong Tagalog (short sleeves) for male and Filipiniana dress for female, P.E. attire and any musical instruments of their choice: guitar, banduria, octavina, ukulele (made of coconut shell if available) or any kind of ukulele, bamboo Flute, Recorder, etc. and Tinting Color (Latex Paint) Toulodine Red, Hanza Yellow, Thalo Blue, Thalo Green and White.**
5. Public Schools District Supervisors, Elementary/Secondary School Principals/Head Teachers are requested to identify the participants either Muslim/Seventh Day Adventist/Christian Catholic so that foods will be prepared for them as Halal or Non - Halal.
6. Meals, snacks and accommodation shall be charged to the **Elementary School Training Funds** while travel and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against **school MOOE or district funds** subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Widest dissemination of this memorandum is highly desired.
