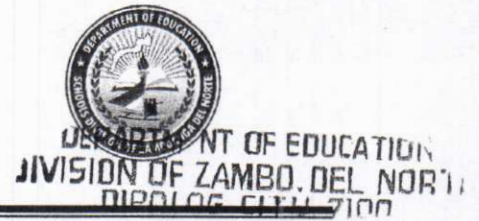

Relative to the conduct of the 2016-2017 DIVISION SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING READING TEACHER for Grades I and 7, an awarding ceremony was scheduled in March 2017 but due to the sudden change of previous SDSs' decision, the awarding was set during this school year's teachers' summit on the occasion of the National Teachers' Month Celebration in October, 2017.

2. This school year's National Teachers' Month Celebration was conducted in the schools. The teachers' summit was no longer conducted in the usual venue. However, the plaques of recognition for the top 10 winners for elementary and secondary levels (Grades 2 and 7) are now ready for release starting December 15, 2017 so that the schools and districts can schedule for an awarding anytime during their major activity before the school year ends (these plaques shall be released personally by EPS in charge in English at the supply office.)

It was indeed a remarkable accomplishment of all the Grade 2 and Grade 7 reading teachers wherein the judging started in the school, district, congressional levels and finally in the division level.
