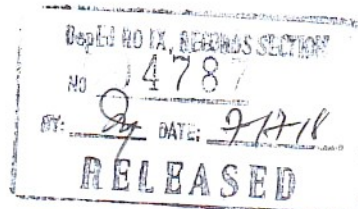

The Citizens' Disaster Response Center Inc. is a non-stock non-profit non-government organization duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. It is accredited by the Department of Social Welfare and Development as a social development agency with a mandate to carry-out community-based disaster management activities throughout the country.

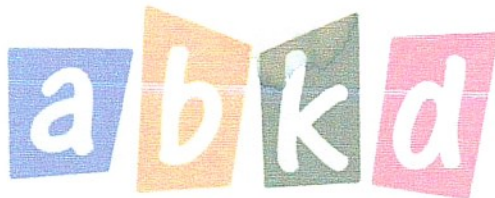

CONTEST MECHANICS

2. Choose only ONE theme per artwork in your category.

Category A

(7-9 years old)

- Earthquake
- Fire
- Landslide/Trashslide
- Environmental destruction due to mining, illegal logging, and other projects

Category B

(10-12 years old)

- Drought
- Fiskhill/Redtide
- Infestation
- Epidemic
- War/Armed conflict
- Climate change

1. Use any medium. Design should be drawn on a 1/4 (20" x 15") illustration board.
2. Indicate category and disaster type.
3. Contest entries should be with titles and captions.
4. Contest entries should be covered by plastic when submitted.
