Subject : **BENCHMARKING OF THE BEST PRACTICES OF CULIANAN LEARNING CENTER, DIVISION OF ZAMBOANGA CITY ON THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF E-IMPACT AS AN ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (ADM)**

Date : August 2, 2018

1. Pursuant to the DepEd Order 54,s.2012 or the Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of Alternative Delivery Modes, this Department ventured on Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs) which aim to primarily address the problems on congestion and other situations, and circumstances which prevent children from going to and staying in school.
2. The DepEd anchored the implementation of ADMs on the following principles: 1) basic education is free and shall be accessible to all; 2) education is a right of every individual; 3) education is inclusive and not discriminating; and 4) stakeholder participation is integral to total child development.
3. In support to DepEd's plans to improve the implementation of ADMs, the Division of Zamboanga del Norte takes an initiative to visit Culianan Learning Center being the first and recognized E-IMPACT implementer in the Division of Zamboanga City on August 16-17, 2018.
4. The objectives of this activity are the following:
  - a. familiarize the principles strategies used by Enhanced-Instructional Management by Parents, Community and Teachers (E-IMPACT) project of Culianan Learning Center;
  - b. identify the best practices of E-IMPACT that may be adopted to address instructional concerns in the multi-grade and far-flung schools.
  - c. enhance partnership among education stakeholders in the community.
5. The list of participants to this activity is found in the enclosure and they are expected to be in Zamboanga City on August 15, 2018.
6. Board and lodging, travel and incidental expenses of the SDS, ASDSs, EPSs, PSDSs and DOIC shall be chargeable against the Division Funds while the board and lodging, travel and incidental expenses incurred by the District Focal persons relative to their attendance to this activity shall be chargeable against School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
