The Division of Zamboanga del Norte announces the conduct of the **2018 Division Special Education (SPED) Festival for Learners with Special Educational Needs (LSENs)** on September 30- October 1, 2018 at Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte with the theme "Kakayahan at Kasanayan Para sa Kabuhayan Tungo sa Kaunlaran" which focuses on the realization of the fundamental freedom and rights of persons with disabilities as provided for in existing international mandates and national laws.

The objectives of the activity are:

1. to provide equal opportunities for all LSENs to acquire the knowledge, skills and values necessary for them to adapt to a changing world;

2. to develop life skills in all learners to ensure their active and sustained participation in all

activities through relevant programs, projects and enabling policies;

3. to prepare the LSENs of this division for their participation to the regional and national levels.

The activities for this event together with the personnel in-charge and the mechanics of the competition are hereby attached for further information and guidance. Coaches are reminded to secure all the necessary requirements needed by all learners to qualify themselves in joining the competition.

Furthermore, only the winners from the cluster level competition are allowed to compete during the said activity, hence all clusters are required to conduct a cluster level competition for the selection of contestants. This activity further encourages the participation of the private schools and will join the cluster where they belong.

Supplies, materials, meals of the identified members of the committees, travel of the division personnel and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be chargeable against Division MOOE funds while the travel expenses, per diem and incidental expenses of the participants shall be chargeable against School MOOE/ LGU/Local Funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. Teachers will be given service credits in lieu of their services rendered on Saturday and Sunday.

Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is so desired.

GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA 2018 DIVISION SPED FESTIVAL FOR LEARNERS WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

September 30-October 1, 2018 Baybay Central School, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Each cluster must have one participant/contestant/entry for every competition. Hence, there will be five (5) entries per contest.
- 2. All coaches, contestants/players, chaperons must register at the assigned registration committee.
- 3. Questions for academic and spelling contests shall be prepared by the team assigned in every exceptionality. Hence, coaches will contribute test items for the academic contests for CWID, CWVI, CWHI, and CWA and also to the other exceptionalities. Clincher questions need not to be read if there are no ties.
- 4. The contestant who gets the highest number of points is automatically declared the Champion; and the second (2nd) highest, third (3rd) highest are the Runners-up.
- 5. Should there be a tie among the contestants getting the highest score or the second (2nd) highest score, the contest continues to the Clincher round to determine the Champion or the Runners-up as the case may be.
- 6. The total number of points of the tied contestants will revert back to zero.
- 7. The duly registered teacher-coach of the contestant is the only person authorized to make a protest.
- 8. All protests should be referred to the committee members immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
- 9. The Board of Judges or the committee members assigned shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/protests.
- 10. Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) winning contestants and certificates of recognition for the coaches. Committee chairmen and members will also receive certificates of recognition.
- 11. The decision of the Board of Judges in all contests shall be final and irrevocable.
- 12. Top three (3) clusters with the most number of points will received a trophy.

A. Poster-Making Contest (HI)

- 1. One contestant from each cluster (1&2, 3&4, 5&6)
- 2. The contestants are required to bring 1/4 size illustration board and their paraphernalia for the poster making. The concept of poster-making must revolve on the theme: "Kakayahan at Kasanayan Para sa Kabuhayan Tungo sa Kaunlaran"
- 3. The contestants' output will be identified by number.
- 4. Contestants will be given exactly three (3) hours to finish their poster.
- 5. Judging will be based on the following criteria.

B. Pop Dance (Pupil Category)

- 1. The contest is open to all SPED pupils enrolled in the schools of Zamboanga del Norte.
- 2. A maximum of ten (10) pupils, distributed to the different exceptionalities as follows 3 HI (25 yrs down), 5 LD (13 yrs down), 2 ID (25 yrs down) are allowed in each performing group.

3. The choreographer of the performing group should be a bonafide employee of the participating cluster.

- 4. Each group will perform a dance number with a minimum time limit of three (3) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes per presentation. The time allotment includes entrance and exit. Beyond this time limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the group's total score.
- 5. Hazardous stunts are highly discouraged.

6. Props may be used, but not necessary.

7. Each group must submit CD of their chosen music to the contest incharge not later than 2 hours before the competition and labeled with their group name. Failure to comply is subject to 5 points deduction in the score.

8. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

C. Folk Dance Contest(HI)

- 1. Any rural folk will do for hearing impairment.
- 2. The contest is open to all bonafide HI pupils.
- 3. The minimum of three (3) pairs and a maximum of four (5) pairs (boy and girl)
- 4. Choreography and formation can be changed for as long as the participants will stick to the dance literature.
- 5. Big backdrops are not allowed on stage, only those that can be lifted by the dancers as they enter and exit the stage are allowed. There shall be no accessories, props, footwear, and backdrops that shall be left when the dancers exit the stage.
