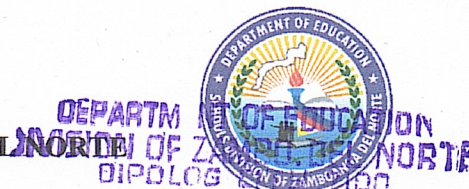

SUBJECT : **PARTICIPATIONS OF ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE DIVISION TO THE SCHEDULED  
2018 ZANDIDAP COUNCIL WIDE SCOUTS JAMBOREE**

DATE : AUGUST 30, 2018

1. Pursuant to the **Council Office Memorandum No. 12, s. 2018** and as duly approved by the Council Executive Board, Commissioners and Coordinators during the conference re: **2018 ZANDIDAP COUNCIL WIDE SCOUTS JAMBOREE** on September 20 – 23, 2018, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte with the theme: "Commitment to Excellence".
2. **Aims and Objectives:** The Jamboree aims to provide a progressive, safe and enjoyable learning environment for the scouts to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials. At the end of the Jamboree, the participant should be able to:
  - 2.1 Promote the highest quality of Scouting, one that is faithful to the mission, principles and methods of scouting and adapted to the needs and aspirations of young people;
  - 2.2 Undertake high – adventure activities, including community service projects related to the current thrust of World Scouting (Environment Education, Peace Education and Development Education through the Messengers of Peace initiatives (MoP), World Scout Environment Program (WSEP) including the Scouts of the World Award (SWA);
  - 2.3 Undergo projects, programs and activities that will cater for the fulfillment of the requirements of the selected merit badges and scout ranks under the scouting advancement scheme.
  - 2.4 Develop core life skills and 21<sup>st</sup> century leadership capabilities through team building, cooperative learning, group dynamics, creative problem – solving and decision-making skills;
  - 2.5 Keep oneself abreast with prevailing issues about environment, human rights, health, education, culture and science and technology through the Global Development Village and cross roads of culture.
3. More than 5, 000 thousand participants coming from the different Divisions, Districts and Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools in Zamboanga del Norte, Dipolog City and Dapitan City are expected to attend the Jamboree. Neighboring BSP Local Councils, other institutions and organizations are also invited to send delegation to this event.



4. Qualifications for participation are as follows:

**a. Scouts**

- Must be currently registered KAB/Boy, Senior Scouts & Rover/Roverette Scouts
- Must have experienced and attended the Institutional Camp/District Camp or trained in PLTC/CLTC courses as pre – requisite to the jamboree.
- Must not be under 7 or over 21 years of age before the start of the Jamboree
- Must be physically fit as certified by a physician.

**b. Adult Leaders**

- Must be duly registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines
- Must have served as Unit Leader/Assistant Unit Leader and Rover Peers
- Must be of good moral character
- Must be physically fit as certified by a physician.

5. As part of the Jamboree activity and Senior High School advocacy, all secondary schools offering Senior High School Program – Technical Vocational and Livelihood (TVL) are requested to showcase their products under the Learn – A – Trade activity of the Jamboree. Immersion site for the Rover/Roverettes for community service, beautification, painting and landscaping. The excess Adult or Unit Leaders for their Team Building Activities.
6. Contingents will bring their own cooking gear, camping gear and equipment's. Contingent will arrange and handle their own transportation requirements from point of origin to the jamboree site, drop – off point and return.
7. A jamboree fee of Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00) for Boy/Senior/Rovers & Adult Leaders and One Hundred Pesos (Php 100.00) for KAB Scouts participant shall be charged to cover the cost of program and activity materials, souvenir items and other administrative cost.
8. Participation fee to the attendance of this activity shall be charged to Local School Board Funds, MOOE, PTA Funds, Local Scouts Fund or from any sources of funds subject to the usual COA accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. All Districts, Elementary and Secondary Schools are expected to organize their Jamboree Committee at this early to ensure maximum participation of scouts. A two (2) days service credits will be given to the jamboree staff and teacher participants.
10. Attached is a copy of the registration application form which you can reproduce to meet your needs.
