- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 084, s. 2018 entitled *Partnership with Philippine Red Cross for the Promotion of First Aid, Youth Development, Volunteerism, Health and Safety, Community Resilience, and the International Humanitarian Law, you are directed to organize the Red Cross Youth (RCY) Council in your respective schools and districts.*
- 2. The Red Cross Youth (RCY) is a dedicated service program of the Philippine Red Cross for young individuals aged 7-25 years old. Its mission is to harness the youth's energy and idealism and provide opportunities to engage into humanitarian action and leadership roles. It seeks to inculcate humanitarian values, instill the practice of a healthy lifestyle, enhance youth leadership through service delivery, and advocate national/international friendship.
- 3. The RCY Council of every school (RCY 143) shall be composed of **one (1) teacher-adviser** and **at least 43 student members**. The following positions shall be elected among the RCY 143 members:

- 4. Furthermore, 43 student members shall be assigned to 5 service groups, namely: Blood Services (8 members), Safety Services (9 members), Health Services (9 members), Disaster Management Services (9 members), and Welfare Services (8 members).
- 5. The RCY Adviser must have the following qualifications:
  - Physically fit
  - Possesses the spirit of volunteerism and humanitarianism
  - Willing to be trained in disaster management, safety, welfare, and community development to be able to predict, plan, prepare and practice against disasters
  - Preferably a licensed driver
- 6. The SSG/SPG adviser of every school shall submit the list of RCY 143 members to the SGOD Office through the Youth Formation Division PDOs or via email at **pdodepedzn@gmail.com** on or before **September 28, 2018**.
