1. This is to inform the field of the Division Mentoring Program, known as the Learning Partnership Program (LPP). LPP is a process whereby a trained or experienced teacher or a group of teachers extends professional support to their colleagues, may they be novice or veteran. In the LPP model, one teacher assumes the role of a Learning Facilitator and the other the Learning Partner and the roles may reverse. Teachers learn together towards mastery of concepts that were identified as Least Learned Competencies of pupils derived from the results of the Students' National Achievement Tests. In this connection, a 3-day Division Training on the Learning Partnership Program (LPP-PHASE 2), among selected Master Teachers in the Elementary Level shall be conducted in three (3) batches on November 26-28, 2018, December 5-7, 2018 and December 12-14, 2018 at a venue to be announced later.
2. The objectives of this training are to:
 - a. capacitate the Master Teachers about the SCOPE tools which will be the basis for the preparation of DLP;
 - b. enhance Master Teachers' knowledge and competence on content and pedagogy.
3. The expected participants are the 35 Master Teachers representing the 35 districts across all subject areas including Kindergarten and SPED – a total of 350 Master Teachers. Respective classes of the Master Teachers must be properly dispensed with to avoid disruption of classes.
4. This is a 3-day live-in training and this is the Phase 2 (mentoring), since Phase I (Assessment) which is the classification test for Master Teachers was already conducted at Polanco and Liloy National High Schools. No registration fee is to be collected from each participant. (Enclosed is the Framework of ZDN Learning Partnership Program for your reference). The participants are expected to bring Curriculum Guides, Teaching Guides, Learners' Materials and Daily Lesson Logs.
5. Travel, per diem and incidental expenses of participants shall be charged to local school funds subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
