 The Zamboanga del Norte Division will conduct a 4 – Day Live-in Training of Trainers on Rondalla Organization Seminar – Workshop and Development of some Indigenous/Localized Musical Instruments through the implementation of MUSICARTPEH Program on October 23 – 26, 2018 at Mibang Hotel, Dipolog City.

2. The objectives of this Training-Workshop are as follows:

- enhance teachers' skills and strategies in organizing rondalla group specifically in note reading and understanding the Elements of Music;
- develop the conceptual understanding and functional skills of teachers in playing musical instruments;
- organize school choir, rondalla and combo lata group in the elementary and secondary schools using the localized/indigenous and scrap materials found in the locality; and to
- manifest a sense of nationalism through deepend appreciation of folks songsand other nationalistic songs among teachers and pupils/students
- 3. The participants to this Training-Workshop are potential teachers who have the knowledge and skills in playing rondalla instruments. Each district will send two (2) participants from elementatary or high school teachers. The said teachers will be the facilitators/trainers during the district Echo —Seminar workshop.
- 4. The arrival, registration and check-in time of participants will be on the Day -0, October 23 at 1:00 P.M., the Opening Program starts at exactly 2:00 P.M. and 1st Session will follow immediately right after the opening program.
- 5. Participants are required to bring Barong Tagalog (short sleeves) for male and Filipiniana dress for female, and any musical instruments of their choice: guitar, banduria, octavina, ukulele (made of coconut shell if available), bamboo Flute, Recorder, etc.
- Travel and other incidental expenses of Facilitators shall be charged against Division Fund while theparticipants shall be charged toschool MOOE/Local funds subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
