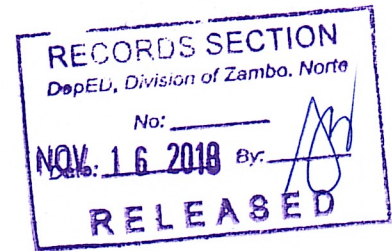

1. Pursuant to President Proclamation No. 476 dated October 7, 1994, November of every year was declared as "Filipino Values Month". In connection with this, the field is hereby informed that the Division Values Education/Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) will hold its 2018 DIVISION FILIPINO VALUES MONTH CELEBRATION, with its theme "**ISULONG TAMANG PAGAARUGA PARA SA LAHAT NG BATA**". This will be conducted on November 29, 2018 at Mibang Hotel, Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte.
2. The prime objective of this celebration is to enhance and awaken our moral and national consciousness on human values as part of the moral recovery of the national government.
3. All schools in the division are encouraged to participate in this event. The planned activities are anchored on the character for the month which in WISDOM versus FOOLISHNESS in the classroom.
4. This celebration will showcase the following competitions/ concerns and suggested activities.

5. Relative to the said activity, the winners in the district/congressional levels will compete in the Division Level and that will be conducted on the following dates:

6. The participants to this activity during the Division Level will be the winning students/pupils in the different levels with their teacher-coaches and school coordinators in-charge of EsP.



7. The schools are expected to conduct a culminating activity on the last week of November. All activities must be documented and submit accomplishment report to the division on or before December 11, 2017.
8. Herewith is the enclosure of the Division Guidelines/Mechanics and Criteria in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Competition. This will also serve as the criteria for our District and Division Level EsP Competitions.
9. Transportation and other allowable expenses of the participants and coaches both for cluster/districts and secondary teachers shall be charged against School MOOE or other sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.

**GUIDELINES/MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR 2018 EDUKASYON SA  
PAGPAPAKATAO COMPETITION**

a. **Tagis-Talino**

1. There will be one entry per category for every level in each team/category. For the elementary category are from Grades IV and V and VI while from the Secondary are from Grades 7, 8, 9, and 10 students.
2. The team will compete in three rounds, namely, the Easy (1pt.), Average (3 pts.) and Difficult (5 pts.) levels.
3. The quizmaster will read each test question twice and after the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading the quizmaster will signal for the raising of their answers. The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard. ( ¼ illustration board c/o coaches)
4. The highest scores will be declared winners. (Champion, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> Runners-up). The top 3 teams will receive individual medals with certificates and the rest will receive certificates of participation including the coaches.

b. **Minus-One Praise Song**

1. There will be one contestant per category for every grades level per school for both elementary and secondary district school level. Only the winner (Champion) will reach the division level.
2. The song must be either English or Filipino and must be a song of praise or worship or religious/inspirational.
3. It must be a whole song and not be remixed.
4. The contestant and the teacher-coach must check the minus one with the sound system in-charge to ensure that the CD/USB is functional and that no vocal/lyrics heard once it is on.
5. The following are the criteria for judging:

Voice Quality	-	25%
Interpretation	-	25%
Diction and Clarity	-	25%
Stage Presence	-	15%
Audience Impact	-	10%
<b>Total</b>	-	<b>100%</b>
6. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> placers will receive medals with certificates while the rest will receive certificates so with the teacher-coaches.
7. The decision of judges is irrevocable and final.

c. **On-The-Spot Poster Making**

There will be one (1) entry per Congressional Districts. (Three from the elementary and three from the secondary.)

1. The contest is open to Grade 5 (elementary) pupil and Grade 9 secondary.
2. Each participant should submit one (1) entry only.
3. During the contest proper the pupil/student shall bring the following: Contestants are advised to bring their own materials.
  - a. Half white cartolina
  - b. Coloring material: oil pastel/crypas/ markers, ink, mixed media, oil acrylic and watercolor (to be provided by the contestant)



4. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme.
5. The participants will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.
6. The poster will be judged according to the following criteria:

Relevance to the theme	30%
Originality	25%
Creativity	20%
Color Harmony	15%
Visual Impact/Presentation	<u>10%</u>
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>100%</b>

7. Entries must be submitted after ONE HOUR. Posters must be done in free hand the artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.

d. **My Hero (Medium: English)**

1. The contest is open to Grade 11 and Grade 12 student.
2. The contestant shall deliver a 2-minute speech about his/her chosen hero (national or local hero).
3. The contestant should be ready to answer questions from the panelists.
4. Criteria for judging are as follows.

Organization	-	35%
Content	-	35%
Delivery	-	20%
Stage Presence	-	<u>10%</u>
<b>TOTAL</b>	-	<b>100%</b>

e. **Essay Writing Contest (medium: Filipino)**

1. The contestant is open to Grade 6 (elementary) pupil and Grade 10 secondary.
2. Each contest should submit one (1) entry only.
3. The contestant shall bring a black pen. The contest in-charge shall provide the writing sheets.
4. Contestant is not allowed to write his/her name or any identifying mark on the paper.
5. The essay should have 300-350 words.
6. Entries must be submitted after ONE HOUR writing, with the Theme:
7. The essay will be judged according to the following criteria.

f. Content (relevance to topic)	35%
g. Organization (unity of thought, flow of discussion)	35%
h. Style (originality, creativity)	20%
i. Mechanism (grammar, punctuation)	<u>10%</u>
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>100%</b>

8. There will be three winners in the elementary and three winners in the secondary.

f. **Slogan Making**

1. The contest is open to Grade 4 (elementary) pupil and grade 8 student.
2. Each participant should submit ONE entry only.

3. Materials to be used in slogan making contest are the following:

- ¼ illustration board
- Pentel pen
- Pencil
- Ruler

4. The slogan shall be written in Filipino and the number of words shall not be more than 15 words and minimum of 10 words.

5. The slogan shall be judged based on the following criteria:

Relevance to the theme	-	40%
Clarity of message	-	20%
Creativity	-	15%
Originality	-	15%
Impact & Presentation	-	10%
<b>TOTAL</b>	-	<b>100%</b>

6. Entries must be submitted after ONE HOUR of working. Posters must be done in free hand and the artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.

7. Participants have to take note that the Essay writing contest for Grades 4 and 8 and the Slogan Making contest for Grades 6 and 10 with the theme: “*MAPANURING PAGGAMIT NG GADDGET: TUNGO SA MA PAGKALINGANG UGNAYAN SA PAMILYA AT KAPWA*” should be written in Filipino medium. The Poster making contest for Grades 5 and 9 and the My Hero (SPEECH) contest for Grades 11 and 12 with the theme: “*MORAL AND INNOVATIVE LEADERSHIP: NEW MODELS OF EDUCATION TRANSFORMATION AND DEVELOPMENT*”, should be in English Medium.

8. There will be three winners in the elementary and three winners in the secondary.

9. Winners and coaches will receive Certificates of Recognition.
