# Guidelines and Mechanics for the Research Presentation

# I. Research Topics / Duration of the Research Endeavor / Review Process

Research outputs to be presented are preferably in line with the conference theme specifically on: (a) teaching strategies; (b) classroom management; (c) learning assessment; (d) technology integration; (e) the teacher and the teaching profession; (f) educational management; (g) ethical and legal aspects of teaching; (h) pedagogical perspectives; (i) life-skill and lifelong learning; and/or (j) other relevant issues confronting the educational system in the Philippines and Asia (k) cultural education; (l) cultural diversity management; (m) language research relating to education; (n) the role of culture in improving educational systems. Research works must have been conducted for the last three (3) years, unless a research endeavor undertaken for the past five (5) years is still relevant to the present and has not been widely disseminated.

Each paper will be reviewed by the Research Committee and will be evaluated based on the criteria such as originality/novelty, technical depth/merit and quality of presentation.

#### II. Abstract Format

### A. The abstract should include:

- 1 Title
  - (Include name of researcher, school affiliation, contact number and email add)
- 2. Introduction / Rationale
- 3. Methodology
- 4. Results, Conclusions and Recommendations
- Keywords Th

There must be five (5) keywords to be included in the abstract.

### 7. References

Use the typeface font of 12 point Arial, Word document format in not more than one page, short-sized bond paper, single-spaced.

All accepted research papers will be included in the conference

proceedings to be distributed during the conference as part of the kit.

# III. Powerpoint Specifics for the Oral Presentation

Each research work shall be presented in no more than 10 minutes and must be supported by a Powerpoint presentation which will be sent ahead of time via e-mail, together with the abstract and the name/s of author/s. The presenter must limit him/herself to 8 slides only, of which each slide must contain maximum of 10 lines only for clearer visual projection. Hence, due to limited time of presentation, presenters are requested to reduce or limit unnecessary explanations and/or elaborations.

In order to have common / parallel format, the following set of standards is required:

(aligned with the SOP presented in one slide)

IV. Submittal Procedures and Notification to Authors

- (a) Abstracts and powerpoint presentations should strictly follow the specifications indicated in the guidelines and must be submitted to Dr. Dino Joey L. Cordova at bluewaves614@gmail.com. Submission of entries should not be later than February 7, 2018
- (b) If an author is submitting more than one abstract, the same "Author and Presenter's Information and Disclosure Template" can be used for every submittal. For team research, at least one of the authors must present the paper during the conference.
- (c) The Research Committee (PAFTE IX Officers), through its Chair, shall inform the presenters of accepted papers for presentation through email not later than **February** 15, 2018.
- (d) To note, research entries will pass through initial screening of the committee.

# V. Publication of PAFTE Research Journal (Refereed and CHED Accredited)

- Authors of selected research papers will be notified for the submission of the full papers to be published in the PAFTE Refereed Journal.
- Content format and other pertinent details and guidelines will be attached in the notification.
- To note, the Association reserves its right to edit and/or reformat the research entries for publication upon recommendation of the pool of referees and evaluators.
- 4. Authors will be provided with complimentary copies of the said journal.
