OUTSTANDING READING TEACHER (SORT) IN THE CLUSTER
LEVEL (POMAROKA, USSAA, MAINLAND GIANTS, TRIPLE SB
FIGHTERS AND NORTHERNINERS)**

Date : January 17, 2018

1. In relation to the Division Level Competition of the SORT on March 8, 2018 at Ponot NHS for the secondary level and Ponot CS for the elementary level, all the Public Schools District Supervisors are enjoined to submit the official and final results in the cluster level of both elementary and secondary levels to the division office on or before February 22, 2018 (attn.: EPS, English).
2. The main purpose of this submission is for the division classroom evaluators to know the cluster winning schools to be evaluated and their schedule is on February 26, 27 and 28, 2018 per approved travel order. They cannot start the evaluation without your results. These results must be clearly stated in the form provided by the division office attached in the memorandum dated December 21, 2017. (CONSOLIDATED RESULTS OF THE SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING READING TEACHER)
3. It is expected that all schools will have their contestants. The rank list to be submitted must include all the contestants with their ratings. All the cluster contestants will receive certificates of recognition from the division office.
4. The coverage of the competencies to be utilized for demonstration teaching are to be lifted from Quarters 1, 2, 3 and week one of Quarter 4 of the grades III and IV curriculum guides.
5. Below is the specified criteria from each criterion for classroom evaluation, but the criteria for demonstration teaching and interview holds true.

CRITERION I - Teachers Portfolio

- Certificate of recognition as winning coach to communication arts activities (including private competitions related to English)

- National Level	-	5 pts
- Regional Level	-	4 pts
- Division Level	-	3 pts
- CD Level	-	2 pts
- School Level	-	1 pt

Only the points of the highest level must be considered.
(e.g. if the contestant is a winning coach in the national level – he is only entitled to 5 points the regional and division level points must not anymore be considered.

- Certification as demo teacher

- National Level	-	5 pts
- Regional Level	-	4 pts
- Division Level	-	3 pts
- CD Level	-	2 pts
- School Level	-	1 pt


- Certificate of Recognition as winning coach to the division, regional and national schools press conference.

- National Level - 5 pts
- Regional Level - 4 pts
- Division Level - 3 pts

- CRITERION 2
- Soft copy of the teacher's best practices for the last three (3) years (5pts)
 - During the evaluation, the contestant will now have the video presentation of all his reading practices in the school. Then after which, the evaluators will conduct an ambush interview with the principal, co-teacher and students about the veracity of the activities shown and the impact to the students' reading abilities.
- CRITERION 3
- Classroom structuring with CARE & SHARE and ilove2read materials, contextualized IMs and complete school forms. (10 pts)
 - These forms refer specifically to Forms 1, 2 and 3 of the 2 reading programs, reading contracts, and reading progress report and attendance sheets or logbook they signed in every time they report to their reading corners.
- CRITERION 4
- Evidence of participation to various communication arts activities starting 2015-2016 last year up to present. (10 pts)
- evidences may include:
- * certificate of participation
 - * certificate of appearance
 - * travel completed/travel order
 - * memorandum
 - * certification from the principal/PSDS regarding their participation
- CRITERION 5
- Zero non-reader and availability of learner's portfolio (with reading logs and reading contacts. (10pts)
 - let the student reads
 - availability of reading contracts/logs, thru these contacts you will find out how many stories/books have the students read – its impact? Student/s become/s better reader/s.
 - Evidence of comprehension – the evaluators are requested to bring texts, or selections suited to the grade 3 of grade 8 levels, let the students read the text and ask them questions – you may let them read only part of the selection.

6. From the cluster level winners, only TOP THREE will qualify to join in the division level at Ponot NHS and Ponot CS. Therefore, only 15 contestants for secondary and 15 contestants for elementary will vie for the title; Outstanding Reading Teacher for SY 2017-2018. Top ten will receive plaques of recognition while top 11 to 15 will receive certificates of recognition for secondary and for the elementary level, top ten will also be awarded plaques of recognition and certificates of recognition will be given to the top 11 to 15 winners.
