ATC - Kawan Leaders (Teachers teaching Grade 1 to 3)

ATC - Outfit Advisors (Teachers teaching Grade 7 to 10)

2. Qualification for Admission:

- a. Must be currently registered with the BSP.
- b. Must be in good health as certified by a registered physician.
- c. Has been conferred with the BTC Completion Certificate and duly certified by the CSE/Training Commissioner.
- 3. Course Fee: Each participant shall be charged FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (Php 5, 000.00) to cover meals, snacks, souvenir items, training materials, handouts and other administrative training cost. Meals will start on January 19, 2018 (dinner) until January 27, 2018. The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses are chargeable against MOOE/local funds or local school board funds or solicited from other agencies subject to auditing rules and regulations.
