1. In consonance to the division's initiatives for the implementation of the IP Education and as part of the Four Minima and Mother Tongue Based Multilingual Education (MTB-MLE) for Kindergarten to Grade 3, this office will conduct the 3-Day Write-Shop on the Development of Big and Small Books for the Kolibugan Orthography at Top Plaza Hotel, Dipolog City on February 25 (1:00PM) to February 28, 2019.

2. This activity specifically aims to:

- a). To produce and collect storybooks for K-III Kolibugan Learners aligned with the k to 12 Curriculum.
- b). To augment the repository of big books/storybooks for the teachers utilization in the schools where there are Kolibugan Learners.
- c). implement a working partnership with the Kolibugan Indigenous Cultural Communities.
- 3. The participants of the training are coming from the identified schools implementing Indigenous Peoples Education with Kolibugan learners (copy is hereby attached) and are requested to bring the **Kolibugan attire** for the **cultural presentation**.
- 4. Participants are expected to arrive at the venue on or before 1:00 PM of day O, February 25 for the registration/ settling in rooms in the hotel. The program and session proper shall then commence at exactly 2:00 PM.
- 5. Facilitators and staff are advised to be in the venue at 8:30 AM of February 25, 2019 for the preliminary activities and debriefing.
- 6. Meals and accommodation, fare and honoraria of IP Elders/Resource Persons, travel expenses of the facilitators coming from the schools/districts, supplies & materials and other expenses relevant to the conduct of the said activity are chargeable against the Division IPED Program Support Funds while travel expenses of the participants are chargeable against local funds/MOOE subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and procedures.
