Contestants....get ready... Please advise all teachers to do SORT everyday. Think that everyday is a SORT day so that they will be ready for this finale activity in English by January 2020 of the coming school year.

- Awarding of the PLAQUES OF RECOGNITION of the 2018-2019 SORT (Grade 4 & Grade 9) winners held at Langatian NHS/Roxas CS will be done during the 3rd DMANCOM anytime.
- All the lower level competitions (school, district and cluster) must be done earlier this S.Y. 2019-2020 to catch up with the national level that will be held in January, 2020. Last year the national level was done in March 2019, but this year, the deadline for application online was last January 19, 2019. However, all the qualified applicants this will be recommended this coming S.Y. 2019-2020.

ANOTHER RELEVANT FEATURE OF THE SORT

- For this year S.Y. 2019-2020 the competition will be expanded to Math and Science. This will be the Search for the Best English, Math and Science (EMS) Teacher. This three (3) subjects use the same medium of instruction. The focus of these three (3) subjects in this contest is READING. However, the guidelines for SORT in English hold true. These will all be stipulated in the memorandum for SORT anytime.... Math and Science will also have similar criteria but for the specifics the two Supervisors for Math and Science will take charge.
- All the PSDSs and school heads are enjoined to furnish this office the names of their SORT contestants in June. It is also a requirement that all SORT contestants (English), WAIS contestants (Science) and all MATHALINO (Math) contestants in the Elementary and Secondary Levels, must handle a section of basic readers for secondary level, while for elementary level basic readers, must be identified. REASON: To find out how much the teacher will be doing for these struggling readers:
