- DepEd Order No. 51, s.2004, mainstreamed the Culture-Sensitive Program for the Muslim Pupils, Out-of School Youths, and Adults in the country, the rightful and legitimate aspiration to have a Madrasah Education Program (MEP) that is authentic and appropriate for Muslim population for the interest of the National unity and for the implementation of the 1996 peace agreement. Madrasah Education is declared a vital component of the National Educational System.
- 2. In view hereof, this office announces the conduct of the 2<sup>nd</sup> DIVISION MEP AND ALS-ALIVE TEACHERS' CONGRESS CUM EIDHUL ADHA FESTIVAL 2019 on August 29-30, 2019 at JKC Royale Traders' Inn, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte, with the following objectives to wit:
  - a. Update on the ZN Initiated Programs, Best Practices and MEP data;
  - Capacitate MEP and ALS-ALIVE Mobile Teachers on the Roadmap, Updates of Madrasah Education Program (MEP) and Policies;
  - Showcase the talents and skills of MEP and ALS-ALIVE Mobile Teachers through the exhibitions of their performances; and
  - d. Strengthen camaraderie among MEP and ALS-ALIVE Mobile Teachers.
- 3. During this activity, there will be MEP and ALS-ALIVE Teachers' MUSABAQAH (Skills Exhibition). The different categories and numbers of contestants to participate for the said activity per Cluster are the following:

- 4. Prior to the said activity, an Emergency Meeting of District MEP Coordinators, MUSABAQAH Category Officials and Working Committees shall be conducted on August 16, 2019 (8:00AM) at Palandok ALS-ALIVE CLC, Palandok, Leon B. Postigo, Zamboanga del Norte for the pre-planning and orientation of MUSABAQAH Category Guidelines.
- 5. The MEP Implementing Clusters III, IV and V are required to bring one (1) "Tutup" and one (1) "Talam" for their assigned "DULANG" to be served on August 30, 2019. Participants and contestants are also required to wear their casual Muslim attire during the night of EIDHUL ADHA FESTIVAL on August 29, 2019 and Closing program on Aug 30, 2019.
- The Cluster heads are required to prepare a 15-20 minutes PowerPoint presentation of their 3 years MEP data, accomplishment report and best practices on Aug 29, 2019 after the Opening program.
- 7. Arrival of the Facilitators, Management Team and Participants will be on August 29, 2019. Registration will start at 11:00 AM to 1:30 PM and an Opening Program will follow at exactly 2:00 PM on the same day and venue. Dinner will be the first meal to be served on August 29, 2019. Check out of participants will be on August 30, 2019 at 12:00 NN, but the identified Technical Working Group (TWG) and the Working committee for the stage décor are required to be at the venue on August 29, 2019 at 9:00AM for the preparation and decoration. - 8. Expenses relative to the conduct of the said activity and the Emergency Meeting including board and lodging, supplies and materials shall be charged against Division Funds. Traveling and other incidental expenses of the Facilitators, Judges, and Division participants including ALS-ALIVE Mobile Teachers shall be charged to Division Funds while the Regular and Contractual MEP Teachers shall be charged against School MOOE/Local Fund subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and procedures. #### 1. Mechanics

1.1 There shall be one (1) participant coming from the Clusters 3, 4 & 5.

- 1.2 During the contest proper, the participants shall be seated at the designated holding area. They should not see the process undergone by the contestant on stage.
- 1.3 The participants take turns on stage to identify the letters engraved/cut on illustration board within one minute. The facilitator mixes the 28 letters as they take their turns.
- 1.4 There shall be one (1) timekeeper/buzzer, one (1) recorder/tabulator, one (1) tabulator and three (3) panels of judges.
- 1.5 Timekeeper will signal the start and the end of time allotted for each participants.
- 1.6 The recorder tallies the scores.
- 1.7 Panel of judges shall confirm the number of the correct responses.
- 1.8 The three participants with the highest number of correct answers in a shortest recorded time shall be declared as the winner. There will be first, second and third winners. In case of tie, another three (3) letters shall be added to twenty-eight (28) letters for the clincher round to be given by the board of judges to determine in the place/rank from which they tied.

#### 1. Mechanics

- 1.1 There shall be one (1) participant coming from the Clusters 3,4 & 5.
- 1.2 The participants shall read the selected surah in Tarteel.
- 1.3 Each participant should bring a copy of Holy Qur'an".
- 1.4 The participant shall be seated on the floor with the book stand and using a microphone in the actual reading of the selected *surah*.
- 1.5 The participant shall read the *Surah* or *ayah* in Tarteel within five (5) minutes.
- 1.6 The three participants with the highest scores shall be declared as first, second and third winners.

1.7 In case of tie in any of the top of three ranks, clincher round shall be given by board of judges to determine in the place/rank from which they tied.

1.8 There shall be one (1) time keeper, one (1) recorder, one (1) tabulator and three (3) panels of Judges.

#### 1. Mechanics

- 1.1 There shall be one (1) participant coming from the Clusters 3, 4 & 5.
- 1.2 The participant performs the Adhan verbally in a maximum of five (5) minutes including the preparation. Zero point five (0.5) will be deducted from the total score if time exceeds.
- 1.3 The proctor (one of the judges) shall say "Ibda" (start), then, the participant begins to perform the adhan and may opt to stop when the bell/buzzer rings.
- 1.4 There shall be first, second and third winners to be declared. In case of tie in any of the top of three ranks, clincher round shall be given by board of judges to determine in the place/rank from which they tied.
- 1.5 There shall be one (1) time keeper, one (1) recorder, one (1) tabulator and three (3) panels of Judges.
- 1.6 The time keeper shall ring the buzzer to end the allotted time.
- 1.7 The time recorder and tabulator shall record the time and tally the scores.
