- 1. The Zamboanga del Norte Division will conduct the Two-Day Day Live in Enhancement Training of Trainers on Content and Teaching Strategies in Music and Arts through the implementation of the MUSICARTPEH Program on December 12-13, 2019 at Mibang Hotel, Sta. Filomena, Dipolog City.
