Dr. H.K. Prihartono AH, Drs. S. Sos., S.Kom., MM is an accomplished individual whose




achievements are manifested in the field of education, and in business. He obtained his Doctor of Philosophy in Marketing Management from Padjadjaran University in Indonesia.
