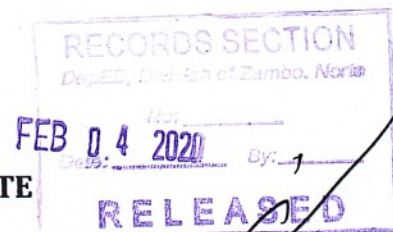

Advocacy Program by Dipolog School of Fisheries


The Dipolog School of Fisheries (DSF) requests to conduct an advocacy program to Grade 11 and 12 students at the schools within this division (see attached).
