RATIONALE

ELIGIBILITY

The participants must be officially enrolled and bona fide learner/personnel of Zamboanga del Norte Division.

GUIDELINES

Answer the question "How can we strengthening the NDEP activity in school at this pandemic time?" in relation to the One Health Week Celebration with the theme: "Bayanihan para sa Kalusugan: OK sa DepEd, sa Paaralan, at sa Tahanan," emphasizing how partnership for school health are essential to support the new school year that will remain under the "new normal" set-up.

Should be an electronic file in jpeg format with 300DPI (dots per inch) or print resolution of 3508 pixels x 4961 pixels

20% - Originality


20% - Creativity
