

- 1. In view of the Dipolog's IATF pronouncement that October 16-31, 2021 will be in Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) Category wherein limited face to face is allowed, this division announces the conduct of the **Division Writeshop on the Contextualization of A&E Elementary ALS Lessons with Emphasis on Modified Flipped Learning Approach** on October 26-28, 2021 at Mibang Hotel, Dipolog City.
- 2. In adherence to the minimum health protocol by the local IATF, all participants are advised to bring their own face masks and face shields and to wear them at all times during the duration of the activity in order to achieve a safe, healthy and productive engagement.
