- 1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 430, s. 2021 signed by Dr. Pedro Melchor M. Natividad, CSEE, OIC, Office of the Assistant Regional Director, dated October 13, 2021 re: 2021 Online Regional Festival of Talents Selection of Audio Visual Presentations (AVP) Entries to 2021 Online National Festival of Talents (NFOT) with the theme, "Demonstrating Resiliency of Learners During Covid 19 Pandemic through Showcasing of Skills and Talents in the Culture and the Art, and Technology" the Regional selection is set on October 28-30, 2021.
- 2. In order to recognize the academic performance of the MEP pupils and ALIVE in ALS learners and giving them the chance to show their skills and talents, this office through Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct the 6th VIRTUAL DIVISION MEP AND ALIVE IN ALS SKILLS EXHIBITION (MUSABAQA) on October 26, 2021 with the following purposes stated under:
 - a. provides the MEP and ALS-ALIVE learners with appropriate and relevant opportunities through competition;
 - showcases various products and performances as proofs of the pupils/learners learning;







- strengthen and upgrade the learners level of competence in facing life's challenges;
- d. reinforces support of administrators, key officials, parents and communities to the Madrasah Education Program (MEP) and ALIVE in ALS program.
- 3. The MEP & ALS-ALIVE Implementing Clusters-Districts and Community Learning Centers (CLCs) will conduct the selection for the Qiraatul Qur'an (Qur'anic Reading) and Adhan (Call to Prayer) categories adopting the mechanics of the two (2) categories of the 6th VIRTUAL DIVISION MEP AND ALIVE IN ALS SKILLS EXHIBITION (MUSABAQA) attached to this memorandum.
- 4. Each Cluster MEP & ALIVE in ALS Districts shall submit their Audio Visual Presentation (AVR) with maximum of five (5) minutes including a short introduction. The material should be in a high definition 1280 x 720 30 fps video format or a video of good broadcasting quality in MP4 format. Follow the sample file name for Cluster MEP A (CMA): Adhan CMA 2021Musabaqa.
- 5. Deadline for submission of entries is on or before October 25, 2021 at 12:00NN through email address: yusoph.dauh001@deped.gov.ph
- 6. The Division Selection Board shall be chaired by Division MEP Focal, Yusoph A. Dauh with the Cluster MEP Heads and identified three judges from other divisions. The MEP Qur'anic Reading entry shall be the official entry to the 2021 Online Regional Festival of Talents Selection of Audio Visual Presentations (AVP) Entries and will be submitted to the Regional Office on October 27, 2021 as stipulated in the 2021 RFOT Guidelines, while MEP Adhan, ALS-ALIVE Qur'anic Reading and ALS-ALIVE Adhan categories shall be entries in the 6th VIRTUAL DIVISION MEP AND ALIVE IN ALS SKILLS EXHIBITION (MUSABAQA) only.
- 7. MEP and ALS-ALIVE Teacher-Coaches and learners who will participate in this showcase of talents and skills will receive certificates of participation and recognition, while the declared Champions with their coaches shall join and be given plaques of recognition during the 2nd DIVISION MEP & ALS-ALIVE PRAISE AWARDS 2021.

6th DIVISION MEP/2nd ALIVE IN ALS MUSABAQA 2021 Specific Guidelines



- 1. The 6th Division MEP & ALIVE in ALS Musabaqah Skills Exhibition aims to provide the Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) learners & Muslim Out-School children, youths & adults with opportunities to showcase their skills and talents through exhibitions of their performance.
- 2. The 6th Division MEP & ALIVE in ALS Musabaqah Skills Exhibition is focused on the 2 categories: Qur'an Reading (Qiraatul Qur'an) and Adhan (Call to Prayer).
- 3. The Musabaqah showcasing of skills and talents is open to all MEP & ALIVE in ALS learners attending ALIVE classes in the Public schools & in the ALIVE in ALS districts.
- 4. The participating cluster-districts will send a five (5)-minute pre-recorded audio-video clip in video format: 1280x720 30fps Mp4 format of the conducted skills exhibition Qur'an Reading (Qiraatul Qur'an) and Adhan (Call to Prayer) as their official entries in the Google Link provided.
- 5. Follow the sample file name for Cluster MEP A (CMA): Adhan CMA 2021Musabaqa.






	The category aims to improve the skills of the MEP & ALIVE in ALS learners to
OBJECTIVES	 Recite the verse (ayah) / chapter (surah) following the rules of Tajweed Read the verse (ayah) / chapter (surah) with clear voice in tarteel Demonstrate the proper way to pause, continue and full stop in reading the verse with stage presence.

I. Mechanics

- 1.1 Consent must be sought from the parents or guardian of the learner/participant.
- 1.2 During the training, only the coach, participant, accompanied by the guardian should be present in the area. Social distancing and wearing of face mask and face shield must be observed.
- 1.3 The coach or the teacher should secure permit from the Barangay officials for the training of the participant and in the conduct of video recording of his/her participant. In case of strict implementation of the IATF protocols, virtual practice is advisable.
- 1.4 Each cluster-district will send a pre-recorded audio-video clip in video format:
 1280x720 30fps Mp4 format for 5 minutes for the Qur'an Reading Skills Exhibition as an official entry for the category.
- 1.5 Each cluster-district will have one (1) participant in the Qur'an Reading category as a skill exhibition. The participants may either be male or female MEP learners, ages 9-12 years old & ALIVE in ALS MOSCYAS, ages 15 to 40 years old.
- 1.6 The MEP participant shall read Surah Al-Fajr and Surah Ar-Rahman for ALIVE in ALS participant, and should have a copy of the Holy Qur'an for reading.
- 1.7 The participant should wear proper attire (black abaya and white hijab/kombong for female and white tawb/kimon with taqiyah/totob/kopya for male).
- 1.8 The participant shall be seated on the floor with book stand and using a microphone in the actual reading of the selected Surah.
- 1.9 Reading of the selected *Surah* shall be done within five (5) minutes.



- 1.11 Consent must be sought from the parents or guardian of the learner/participant.
- 1.12 During the training, only the coach, participant, accompanied by the guardian should be present in the area. Social distancing and wearing of face mask and face shield must be observed.
- 1.13 The coach or the teacher should secure permit from the Barangay officials for the training of the participant and in the conduct of video recording of his/her participant. In case of strict implementation of the IATF protocols, virtual practice is advisable.
- 1.14 Each cluster-district will send a **pre-recorded audio-video clip in video format:**1280x720 30fps Mp4 format for 5 minutes for the Adhan Skills Exhibition as an official entry for the category.
- 1.15 Each cluster-district will have one (1) participant in the Adhan category as a skill exhibition. The participants may either be **male MEP learner**, ages 9-12 years old & **ALIVE in ALS MOSCYAs**, ages 15 to 40 years old.
- 1.16 The participant should wear proper attire white tawb/kimon with taqiyah/totob/kopya.
- 1.17 The participant performs the **Adzan** verbally in a maximum of **five (5) minutes** including the preparation. Zero point five (0.5) will be deducted from the total score if time exceeds.
