GUIDELINES IN THE SEARCH OF OUTSTANDING ALS-ALIVE, REGULAR AND CONTRACTUAL MADRASAH EDUCATION PROGRAM TEACHER

1. The search is open to all ALS-ALIVE and MEP teachers both with plantilla item and those who are in Contract of Service status who have served the department for at least three (3) years.

2. Screening of nominees will be done in the following levels and schedule:

District Level -

December 3, 2021

Cluster-District Level -

December 6, 2021

Division Level -

December 9, 2021

3. There shall be one (1) entry for each category (ALS-ALIVE, regular & contractual MEP teacher) per Cluster-District level.

- 4. The District MEP Screening Committee (DsMSC) shall be composed of the Public Schools District Supervisor/Principal In-Charge of the District, Cluster-District MEP Head, District MEP Coordinator and MEP Implementing School head. The Division MEP Screening Committee (DMSC) shall be composed of the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, Chief of Curriculum Implementation Division, Division ALS Focal, and Division MEP Focal.
- 5. Awarding Ceremonies for the District and Cluster-District levels shall not be later than the Division Awarding. Division Winners shall be awarded plaques and certificates of recognition during the 2nd Division MEP and ALIVE in ALS PRAISE AWARDS 2021.
- 6. Only the cluster-district winner's document shall be submitted to the Division office for the Division Screening Committee.
- 7. An ALS-ALIVE and MEP teachers who is serving as district MEP coordinator shall opt to choose the category in his/her application for the search. Application for two categories and previously awarded as Outstanding ALS-ALIVE, regular and contractual MEP teacher are not allowed.





IDENTIFICATION OF PROMISING AND EFFECTIVE MADRASAH EDUCATION PROGRAM (MEP) BEST PRACTICES

A. What are practices?

Practice is commonly defined as a methodology, approach, process, or activity to achieve a purpose.

For development workers, practice is a set of meaningfully organized activities used to achieve a desired result. The practice has related steps that are followed sequentially, with consistency.

B. There shall be three (3) entries per Cluster-District level to be submitted to Division MEP Screening Committee (DMSC) attached are the documents and signed Cluster-District Nomination Form. (see attached Cluster-District Nomination Form)

C. What are School Practices?

School practices are activities, processes and methods employed by educators in different aspects of education, including student assessment, classroom instruction, teacher training, curriculum development, management of school resources and stakeholder relations, to achieve desired results in student performance.

D. How does the quest for a Best Practice start?

It starts with advocacy. The search process starts with the approval of the division memorandum by Schools Division Superintendent of the Best Practices Guidelines to the MEP and ALIVE in ALS implementing districts, which then recommends it to the schools for utilization.

Upon receipt, the School Divisions are enjoined to organize the Division MEP Screening Committee (DMSC) that shall take charge of the search, evaluation and certification of Best Practices to be awarded during the 2nd Division MEP and ALIVE in ALS PRAISE AWARDS 2021.

The committee shall be the advocate of the Best Practices program. It shall initiate activities to develop awareness of, heighten interest in, and disseminate information about the program.

A Best Practice may come from two (2) sources: (1) a practice proposed by the school or district with a CONCEPT PAPER for evaluation, confirmation and approved by the Public Schools District Supervisor or Principal In-Charged of the District; (2) an on-going practice by the school or district with an approved CONCEPT PAPER which was identified either by the Division MEP Focal (DMF), Public Schools District Supervisor or Principal In-Charged of the District during their

respective supervisory visits. A Practice obtained from a literature review is not covered by this model, which aims to capture only the best of actual school or district practices.

E. How can school or district-based practices (promising, effective and best) be confirmed?

Schools or districts which want to nominate their own Best Practice and have it confirmed, certified and with an approved concept paper by their Public Schools District Supervisor or Principal In-charge of the District. If the application is accepted, the district may send the members of the Cluster-District MEP Screening Committee (CDMSC) for a preliminary assessment of the practice. If the committee finds some deficiencies, they may provide technical assistance to remove such deficiencies. If the practice is found to be creditable, the committee recommends its certification to the Cluster Head Public Schools District Supervisor being the chairperson of the CDMSC. Subsequently, the committee conducts a formal evaluation of the practice using the Worksheet Rating of a MEP/ALIVE in ALS Best Practice for School Year 2021-2022 attached to this memorandum.


The CDMSC conducts interviews, observations, and analysis of documents and artefacts. The evidences obtained are then used by the CDMSC in evaluating whether or not the practice shall be recommended to the Division MEP Screening Committee (DMSC) as an entry for the 2nd Division MEP and ALIVE in ALS PRAISE AWARDS 2021.

What must be done with a practice that is not confirmed? Since the purpose of the program is not merely to evaluate but to improve the practice, the DsMSC should share the findings with the developers of the practice in order to help them improve the practice.

F. What is the role of Cluster Head PSDS, PSDS or PICD in the quest for a Best Practice?

District MEP Task Force (DMTF), because of their frequent supervisory visits, can look for promising practices. Once a Best Practice is identified, they should immediately initiate the nomination process. With the technical assistance from the Cluster-District MEP Screening Committee (CDMSC), the practice can fine-tuned and can be recommended to the Cluster Head PSDS for assessment, confirmation and approval so that it can be recommended as an entry for the 2nd Division MEP and ALIVE in ALS PRAISE AWARDS 2021.

PSDS or PICD, however, can also play an active role in the production of a Best Practice, and not merely be the one who evaluates and identifies it. As subject specialists they can work collaboratively with teachers in designing and developing

practitioner-friendly innovations to address pressing school or district problems and in the crafting of the required CONCEPT PAPER, which serves as the prime artefact.

What are the possible criteria in identifying Best Practice?

1. Effectiveness

- Has succeeded in fulfilling the objectives for which the objective has been designed;
- Addresses a significant educational need, problem or opportunity; and
- Achieves objectives with affordable resources (time, money, manpower, materials and equipment, etc)

2. Sustainability

- Has demonstrated capacity to maintain and improve its level of efficacy overtime;
- Uses easily and readily available human, physical and technical resources;
 and
- · Highly adaptable to users in various situations and environments

3. Transferability

- Has been adopted already by other users with success;
- Is fully documented from inception to completion;
- Does not require a new set of competencies on the part of the adopters

4. Acceptability

- Is user-friendly; methodology is simple; support materials are easy to use;
- Easily fits the existing administrative structure of the systems; and
- In keeping with existing educational policies, rules and regulations

The above suggested criteria should first be ascertained and inquired from the users and implementers, to include the assigned weights (rank and percentage) per criterion that may total to 100 percent. Otherwise, it will not be owned, always vulnerable to questions and suspicions. With the users'/implementers' participation in its identification, systemownership will be had, and can guide the process of practice documentation, selection and confirmation.


