This agreement can be terminated at any time upon agreement of the parties in written notice. In the eventuality that a party fails to fulfil its obligations under this agreement, the other party can uniformly terminate this agreement provided a written notice of twenty days.

Article 9
Interpretation
This agreement of partnership shall be libriding upon the respective successors, executors, trustees, administrators and representatives of the parties.
The parties provide that this agreement shall be understood as undertaken on behalf of the respective conferences, and not privately between the signatories.
