- Per information received from the Zamboanga del Norte Press Club, Inc., holding of this year's Campus Journalism Seminar-Workshop will be done first in 3 venues they have chosen. Other districts are advised to wait for their schedule.
- For batch 3, this is to be conducted on February 4 and 5, 2023 at Kipit Agro-Fishery High School in Labason.
- This convergence is free of charge and is open to all secondary schools ONLY in the identified districts (BYOP). Each secondary school in each of the identified districts is entitled to only 9 English and 9 Filipino Journalists plus 1 English and 1 Filipino school paper adviser. (Press Club says: only 9 journalists for English another 9 for Filipino because there are only 9 topics to be taken up). A total of 20 per school inclusive of the 2 school paper advisers.
- In support to this annual activity of the press club and considering that they 4. have gone this far in actively honing our campus journalists, each concerned host school is requested by this office to provide lunch for the 12 lecturers for the two-day event.
- Travel expenses of the participating journalists and school paper advisers and lunch of the lecturers shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
