

> The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management **Quick Response and Recovery Taskforce** of the Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte

- 1. In the Exigency of the service and in view of the frequency of weather disturbances affecting our schools, learners, and teachers, this office hereby creates the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Quick Response and Recovery Taskforce DRRM ORRT.
- 2. The DRRM QRR Taskforce is created purposely to ensure timely, adequate, and effective response and recovery interventions in the aftermath of a disaster. The specific functions of the Quick Response and Recovery **Taskforce** shall be guided by the two thematic areas of approach in DRRM, viz:
  - Response undertaken immediately after the onslaught of disaster to save our learners, minimize the impacts of secondary hazards, and ensure safety and learning continuity such as but not limited to, clean-up, installation of learning spaces, the conduct of psychological first aid, evaluation on the schools used as evacuation centers, generation and distribution of learners' kits, teachers' kits, school supplies, and other forms of relief items from various sources and partners.
  - Rehabilitation and Recovery after the onslaught of the disaster. These interventions are intended to restore normalcy by repairing and reconstructing damaged infrastructure and facilities, ensuring adherence to the "build back better" principle. These include catering to the well-being of affected learners and personnel through continuing psychosocial interventions that foster long-term sustainable and resilient development.
- 3. The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Quick Response and Recovery Taskforce upon activation is composed as follows;

The **DRRM QRRTaskforce** shall conduct field monitoring and coordination, and shall **submit a report to the Emergency Management Unit and to the Communication and Coordination Unit** within seventy-two hours after the onslaught of a hazard, and provide updates of the assigned cluster to ensure quick recovery in schools.
- 5. The field monitors shall check and evaluate the safe operation of the school when used as an evacuation center in coordination with the school head. The field monitors of every cluster shall coordinate with the stationed members of the DRRM QRRT, and Communication and Coordination Unit to provide a daily situational report upon activation of the DRRM ORRTaskforce.
- 6. The field monitors shall assess the safety of schools used as evacuation centers for the conduct of possible Psychological First Aid of affected learners and stakeholders for recovery and resilience in education.
- 7. All **District DRRM Coordinators**, **School and District Nurses**, **and School Facilities Coordinators** upon activation of the DRRM QRRT shall render a regular daily report to the respective offices concerned to support the DRRM ORRT until deactivation of the same.
- 8. During Emergency **Public Schools District Supervisors of neighboring districts and schools** will assist the affected schools and districts to support their needs and ensure continuity of education amidst disaster.
- 9. Further, to intensify twinning mechanism during emergency, the surrogate **Education Program Supervisor** is also directed to monitor schools as well as the neighboring districts proximate to area of responsibility and report to the Chief Education Supervisor of the Curriculum Implementation Division for updates and daily situational report.
- 10. The services of the members of the DRRM QRRTaskforce during Holidays, Saturdays and Sundays shall be entitled to one (1) day Compensatory Overtime Credit.
